Points for the finales:

Firs place 100 points, second place 70 p, third place 45p, fourth place 25p, fifth place 15p and sixth place 10p.

2. COMPETITION RULES

1. The competition will run in accordance with the rules of a Slovene Rowing Association
2. Clubs prepare crews separately for the first and the second day of the competition. As far as there will be more than 6 crew entries in separate discipline the regatta organizer will divide crews into groups who will start successively.
3. Medical assistance will be arranged by the Rowing Club Nautilus of Koper.
4. Restraints hold for next categories of competitors:
 - Kids can compete only once, P13 (less than 14 years old) with oars type MACON
 - Junior boys and girls can compete only twice
5. Rowers have to submit membership cards authorized by the competent rowing association.
6. With the entries the clubs have to send the statement that all their competitors are medically examined and able to swim.
7. Competitors get a gold medal for the first place, on Saturday, the first day. On Sunday the final group gets the gold medal for the first place, silver medal for the second place and bronze medal for the third place. There are also practical prizes for the winning crews of the second day of regatta.
8. The common winner of final competitions gets a cup of “Marina Koper”,
